voted to recommend a grant of \$301,000 to the Middlesex Canal Association for the new MC Museum-Visitor Center at the Billerica Falls of the Concord River. The museum will be completed this year, ten years after the 150-year-old wool cloth storehouse at the Falls was given to the Association for adaptive reuse as a museum. The next big project of the Association is turning the towpath of the Middlesex Canal between the Concord and Merrimack Rivers into a multi-use trail. The part in Lowell will begin at the Freeman Rail Trail at Cross Point and end at the Merrimack near the Rourke Bridge.


